Introduction

It is our national responsibility to make appropriate arrangements for the religious education of our future generations, as without such arrangements they can neither develop an understanding of religious knowledge nor can the society cultivate a taste and passion for acquiring religious education. In realizing this responsibility, by the Grace of Allah Almighty, Lajna Imaillah Australia has been blessed with the opportunity to establish the online Ayesha Deenyaat Academy.

Lajna Imaillah Australia has planned several projects to be presented in 2022 as a token of gratitude to God Almighty, on the Centenary Celebrations of Lajna Imaillah. The Ayehsa Deenyat Academy was one of the proposed projects. Hazrat Khalifatul Masih (V) (atba) not only accepted this proposal but on my humble request, very graciously sent a very encouraging and faith inspiring message, laden with prayers. May Allah reward our beloved Huzoor abundantly for this.

The purpose of the establishment of the Ayesha Deenyaat Academy is to adorn the Lajna and Nasirat with the teachings of the Holy Quran, Hadith, Fiqh, books of the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) and other Islamic studies and to create in them a deeper understanding of religion. The purpose of this education is to help them become true and practical Muslims, revolutionize their personal lives, help them become righteous servants of God and enable them to fulfill the respectable role of teachers for the future generations, such that they may continue to be the beacons of knowledge for generations to come. Ameen

Courses in the academy will be carried out in both English and Urdu as required. Also, both long-term and short-term courses will be taught. The Moallama course (The Teachers' Course), which lasts for one year, will include Tajweed-ul-Quran, Tafseer of selected Surahs, Principles of Tafseer, Hifz e Quran, Knowledge of Hadith, Selected chapters of Sahih Bukhari, Fiqh and selected books of the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace). Those who complete this course will be awarded a Teachers' Degree.

Short courses are probably the most interesting aspect of the academy's educational activities. Through short courses, students will be able to learn different Islamic studies as per their opportunity, without the need to make long-term commitments. These courses have different levels due to which every student will have the prospect to enhance their knowledge further at any time.

We have made every effort to ensure that the academy staff is highly qualified in their respective disciplines and have the knowledge and experience of the relevant subject. The teachers selected for the courses in Quran, Hadith, Kalam-ul-Imam and Fiqh, etc., are lajna members well versed in the relevant subjects and experienced in teaching. For example, teachers of the short Hifz e Quran courses are hafiza themselves, while the teachers for Tajweed and Tarteel are officially certified. Additionally, in order to further enhance the knowledge and skills of teachers and keep them technically updated, Lajna Imaillah Australia will be committed, through the Executive Body of the Ayesha Deenyat Academy, to provide refresher courses and workshops from time to time, where International Scholars of the Jamaat will deliver lectures as guest speakers, Inshallah.

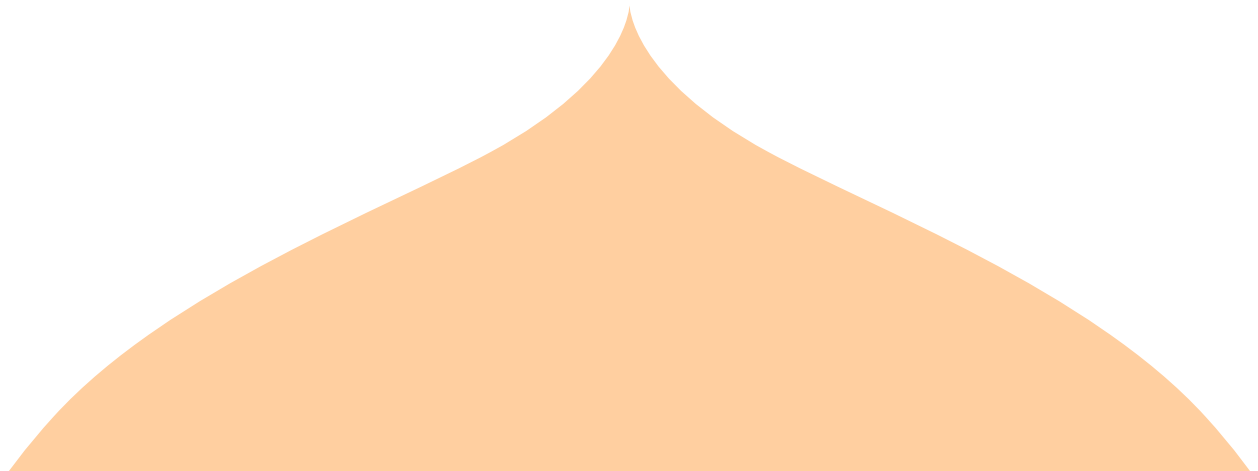

Dear Lajna members of Australia,

I am pleased to know that on the occasion of Lajna Centenary Celebrations, Lajna Imaillah Australia is working on projects of which one is the establishment of Online Ayesha Deenyaat Academy. May Allah bless this initiative and reap pious results. Amin

I have been requested to send a message for the prospectus of this project. My message is that, in our beautiful religion the seeking of knowledge is heavily emphasised. A Hadith states that one should seek knowledge from the cradle to the grave- that is from young age until old age. In another Hadith, the Holy Prophet (saw) stated that the attainment of knowledge is an obligation on every Muslim man and women. Similarly, on another occasion the Holy Prophet (saw) mentioned that whosoever sets upon a journey to seek knowledge, God opens not just the door of knowledge, but also the door of paradise on him.

The Promised Messiah (as) states:

The relationship of a guider and devotee can be understood by the example of a teacher and student. Just as the devotee/disciple reap benefit from their guider, a student also benefits from their teacher. However, if the student does not work to excel and enhance his knowledge- he cannot reap benefit, the same applies to a follower. Hence, one should develop a relation with this community to enhance their knowledge and wisdom. A seeker of truth should not become idle after having reached a level or else the cursed Satan will divert him. Just as still water becomes the source of putridity- similarly if a believer does not try to excel in the matter of faith then he falls. Thus, the work of a seeker of happiness is to continue advancing in the matter of religion. Apart from our Holy Prophet (saw) there existed no man who was so perfect- but even he was informed of the prayer to enhance knowledge "Rabbi Zidni Ilma". So then, who dares to stop their search relying on their limited knowledge and wisdom and feel that he does not need further

improvement? As one advances in the journey of knowledge and wisdom- he will only further realise that abundant things still exist which require a solution. (Translated from Tafsir of Holy Quran by The Promised Messiah- Vol 5 p 293)

It is a great favour of Hazrat Khalifatul Messiah II upon Ahmadi women that such an Auxiliary was established in which they could highlight their potentials. As a result, they can benefit themselves and others from these skills and potentials.

The starting of the Ayesha Deenyaat Academy by Lajna Imaillah Australia is a very blessed initiative. More and more Lajna members should seek benefit from it. On one occasion, Hazrat Musleh Maud (ra) stated:

Analysing the early days of Islam- it becomes apparent that just as the men spread Islam, the women also played their part. And just as men taught Islam, the women also taught Islam....The Holy Prophet (saw) states that if anyone wants to learn my faith then half of it should be learnt from Ayesha.

Hence, applying the noble characters of holy women from early Islam- you should also seek religious knowledge with great passion and hard work. This way you will become remarkably familiar with the Holy Quran, the various blessed *Ahadeeth* as well as the literature of the Promised Messiah (as). You will be better to act and implement upon religious teachings and better train and educate your future generations. Furthermore, such religious knowledge will also serve you in the realm of preaching work, and you can answer the questions and criticism of others on solid grounds bravely. May Allah enable you to reap due benefit from this rare opportunity. Amin

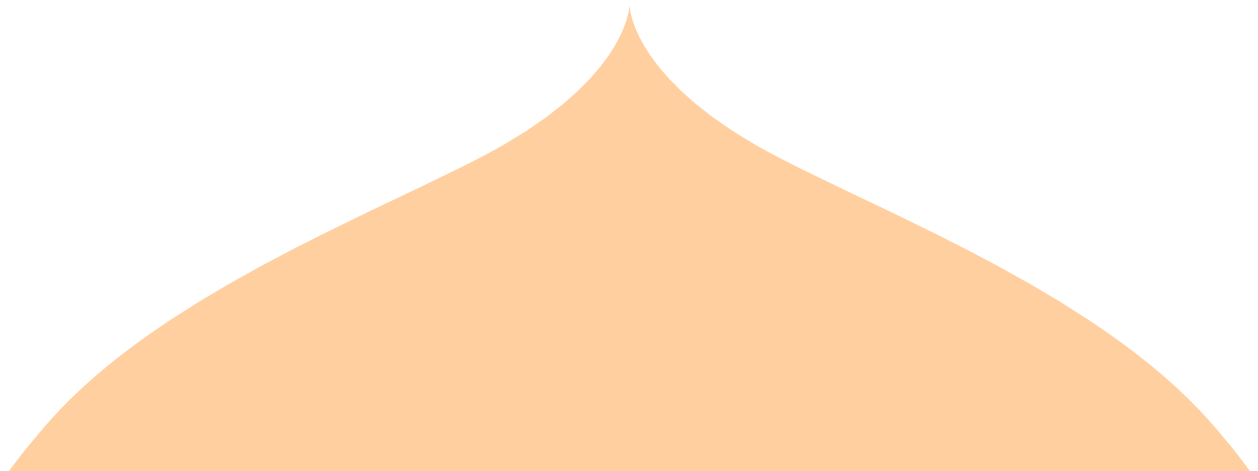

Letter from National President Lajna Imaillah Australia

Assalam o Alaikum Wa Rahmatullah,

Dear Lajna and Nasirat

Knowledge is the food for the soul. Just as the body cannot develop without food, similarly- the soul cannot excel without knowledge. After the creation of man- the first thing which God laid the foundation was knowledge.

The difference between man and other creatures is knowledge. Other creatures cannot excel, while man by using different means can always increase his knowledge.

Whilst relating to Adam (ra)- it is stated in Verse 32 of Surah Al-Baqarah : وَعَلَّمَ آدَمَ الْأَسْمَاءَ كُلَّهَا. From the interpretation of this verse, we know that those who are engaged in expanding their knowledge remain in the place of humanity.

In the second era of the Khilafah Ali Minhaj-ul-Nabwaat, Hazrat Musleh Maud (RA) established Lajna Imaillah for the education and training of Ahmadi women. He worked tirelessly for the education of women throughout his life. He states that "I firmly believe that no nation can prosper without the education of women" (Al-Fadl vol. 19 dated 19 September 1931).

The important role women play in the creation and prosperity of a nation is evident in the revelation of Hazrat Musleh Maud which serves as the motto for Lajna Imaillah: "If you reform fifty percent of women, Islam will prosper". This sentence serves as the path of brightness which our well-wisher has selected for us in order to be successful.

Whilst, he emphasised the importance of education and training of women, he had also clarified exactly what is meant by reform and the type of education that can really lead to true reform. He had repeatedly said that if women gave preference to worldly degrees and do not understand the importance and necessity of attaining religious education, nor pay attention to their household affairs and the training of children, then who can call them wise or well learned individuals?

He repeatedly drew the attention of women that their aim should be to get religious education so that they can contribute to the propagation of the religion, raise their children in the right manner, teach them the Holy Quran, Hadith and the books of the Promised Messiah.

In one of his addresses he said: " Religion cannot succeed unless you make progress. Our progress, our sacrifices will last the most of only twenty or twenty-five years. However if you understand your responsibilities then you can sustain this progress till the Day of Judgment. Because you are the teacher of the future generations. Your influence is permanent and thus understand that it is a heavy burden. It is you who can maintain Islam, and cut off Satan's head. And you can strengthen the progress of your religion in such a way that all nations will be amazed to see. (Flowers of the veiled women, part one, page 62)

"Unless new generations practice the religion and the principles chosen by God and established on earth by His prophets and messengers, they will never be able to move forward in the true sense"

(Sermon delivered on Friday, April 1, 1938, published in Akhbar al-Fadl, April 10, 1938)

By the grace of Allah and after the permission granted by our beloved Hazoor Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad Khalifatul Messiah V (ATBA), Lajna Immaillah Australia started the Online Ayesha Deenyat Academy.

The website was launched on May 21st 2021. We also received a message from Hazur-E-Anwar (ATBA) to the students and teachers outlining the values of Lajna Imaillah and our responsibilities. Enrolment for the 1st Batch of the Moalma Course and Short Courses began on 21st May 2022.

The official classes started on the 16th of August, 2022. The academy offers Moalma Course (1 Year Course) and Short Courses (6 Months Course ranging in different subjects). By 2023 we have had countless students graduate and cultivate the blessings of this Academy!
